National Statistics at <https://ncadv.org/statistics>:

IPV involves approximately 20 individuals per minute in the US

Over 10 million people annually

Most commonly involves women between 18-24

Individuals who are sexually and physically abused have an increase incidence of injury and fatality

Women attempting to leave, disabled, or pregnant are at greatest risk for IP rape

Approximately 324,000 women experience IPV while pregnant annually

Boys witnessing IPV are twice as likely to abuse future partners and children

Lifetime Risks:

1 in 3 women

1 in 4 men

Severe physical violence Lifetime Risks:

1 in 4 women

1 in 7 men

15% of all violent crime

Associated with increased rates of depression and suicidal behavior

Marital rape is the most underreported IPV
